**Risk:** The owner assumes all risk for the donkey up to the point of sale. The buyer assumes all risk at the moment the auctioneer declares the animal is sold. The management is not responsible for loss or damages to personal property.

**Announcements:** All announcements on sale day from the auction block will take precedence over the material printed in this catalog. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the catalog. However, we assume no liability for errors or omissions.
